Role Overview



As an Activities Representative, you will be responsible for fostering a vibrant and inclusive community within your club or society, ensuring that regular events and activities are held to engage members and enhance their overall student experience. You will serve as a voice for your peers, gathering feedback on their needs and concerns, particularly in relation to social and extracurricular aspects of student life. You will also represent student views in key meetings and on relevant committees.

Key Responsibilities



1. Club & Society Management:

- a. Organise and oversee regular events and activities that align with the interests of your club or society members.
- b. Foster a positive, inclusive, and engaging environment that encourages participation and community-building among members.

2. Feedback Collection:

3. Attend Key Meetings:

- a. Participate in compulsory representative training to enhance your skills and knowledge as a student representative.

- a. Maintain regular contact with the Campus Life Coordinator and Student Engagement Coordinator to discuss upcoming events, activities, and initiatives.
- b. Ensure alignment between your club's activities and the university's wider goals for student engagement.

5. Committee Involvement:

a. Be open to being nominated for relevant university committees where you can represent student perspectives, particularly from a social or extracurricular standpoint.

6. Promote a Collaborative Environment:

- a. Work alongside other representatives and student leaders to create a cohesive and dynamic student experience across campus.
- b. Encourage a strong sense of belonging and community within your club or society, enhancing student engagement and satisfaction.

- Regular Contact with Student Engagement Coordinator: Ongoing communication as needed
- Event Planning & Club Engagement: Ongoing commitment to organising and facilitating events and activities
